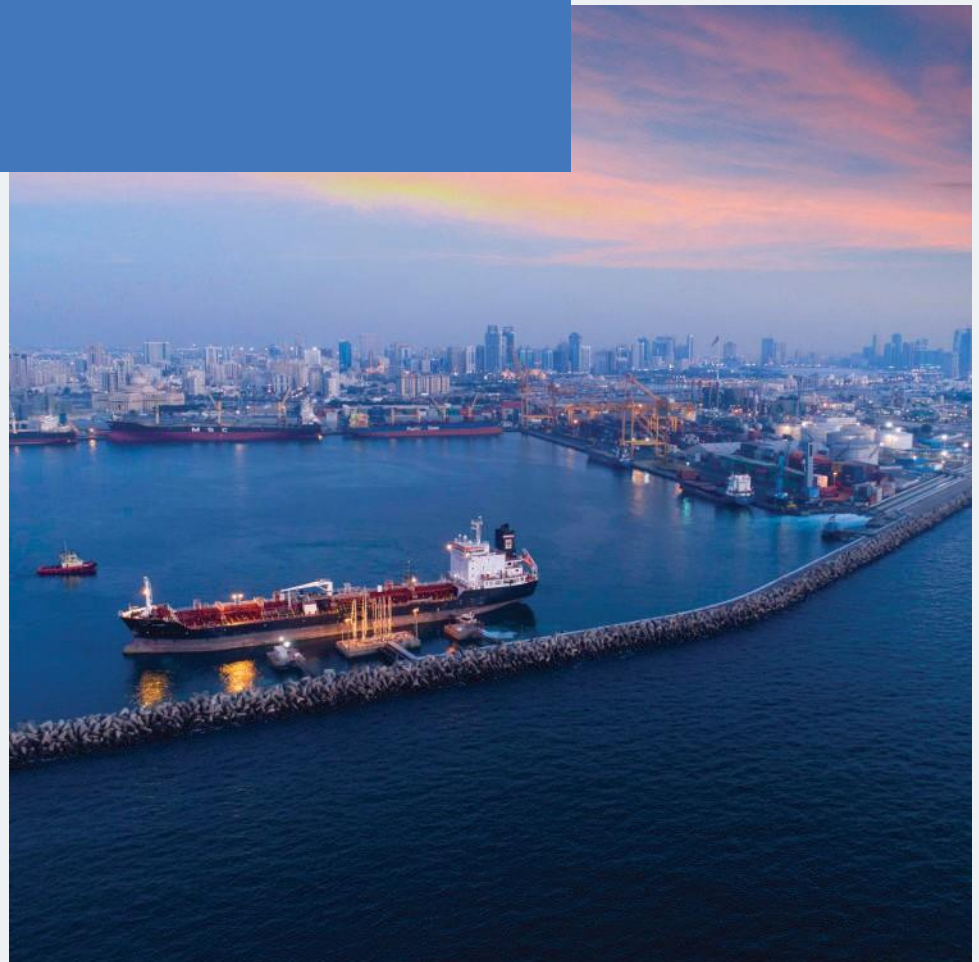

Sharjah Container Terminal (SCT) was the first container terminal in the United Arab Emirates, which began operation in 1976. It is located at the heart of the Emirate of Sharjah which is the third largest of the seven emirates within the UAE.

Building on Decades of Excellence in the UAE and Over 40 Years World Wide

A Brief Timeline of SCT

1976 Operation Began

Gulftainer and the Sharjah Port Authority built and operated the first container terminal in the Arab world and the arrival of the vessel 'MV Tarek' was a significant milestone in transport history.

2007 Major Expansion Plan

SCT celebrates the 30th Anniversary with major expansion plans to include two new post panama gantries, two new MHCs, landside handling equipment and trailers.

2008 Record Productivity Achieved

The first vessel in the latest APL service enhancement called SCT. At 4000 TEU capacity and 40,000 GRT the 'APL ARGENTINA' was one of the biggest container ships ever to berth at SCT, the time pressed vessel was worked at record speed by the terminal with a productivity of over 115 moves per hour.

2009 Volume Increase in Throughput

Khorfakkan Container Terminal (KCT) and Sharjah Container Terminal (SCT) throughput volumes increased by nearly 10% to 2,750,285 TEUs.

2011 Economic Excellence Award

Gulftainer was awarded the 'Sharjah Economic Excellence Award' by the Sharjah Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

2012 Handling Capacity Increased

Completed expansion work to increase draft to 12.5 metres and increase storage/stacking area by 30,000 square metres.

2013 Digital Upgrade

Digital upgrade of SCT's Container Management Systems.

2014 400,000 TEU Milestone

Gulftainer surpasses 400,000 TEU milestone at Sharjah container terminal. The 400,000th unit was discharged from Mag Container Lines' vessel, 'Mag Success', one of the Terminal's regular callers.

2017 Running MACH TOS and SAP For All Cargo

Transitioned to running MACH TOS and SAP operating systems for all cargo and customer transactions.

2018 Record Productivity + New Warehouse

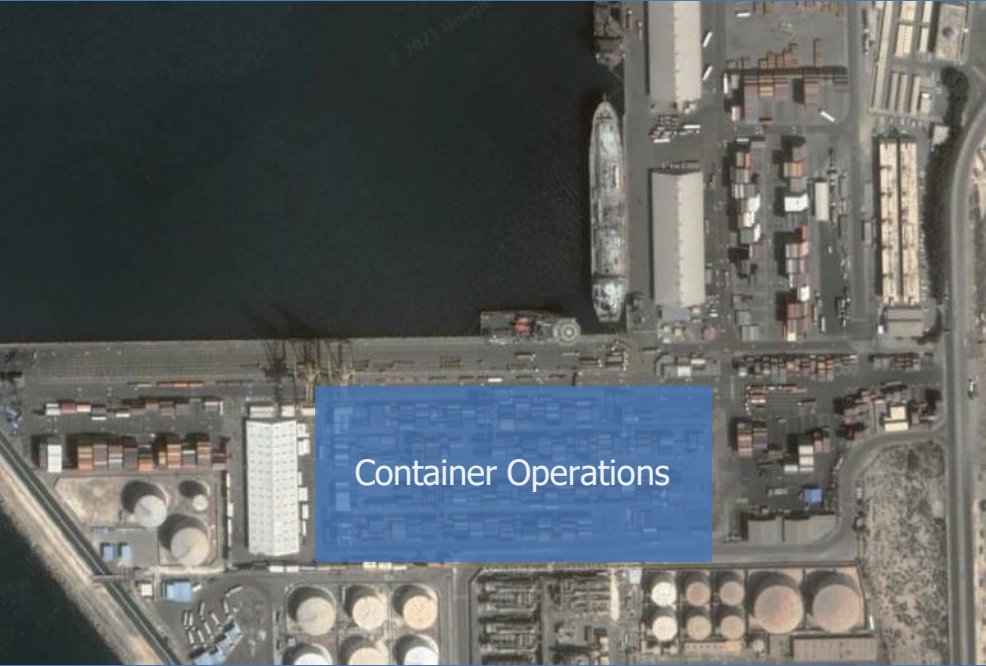
Gulftainer achieves record productivity at the Sharjah container terminal. Port operator witnesses a high demand for a new state-of-the-art warehouse facility, Shed 3.

2019 Yard Expansion Completed

Yard expansion project completed, increasing the terminals' capacity to 14,641 TEU.

2020 Express Service Lane

SCT launched an interim and complimentary 'Express Service Lane' initiative to prioritize the delivery of medical supply consignments at its ports across the UAE to support the nation's COVID response.

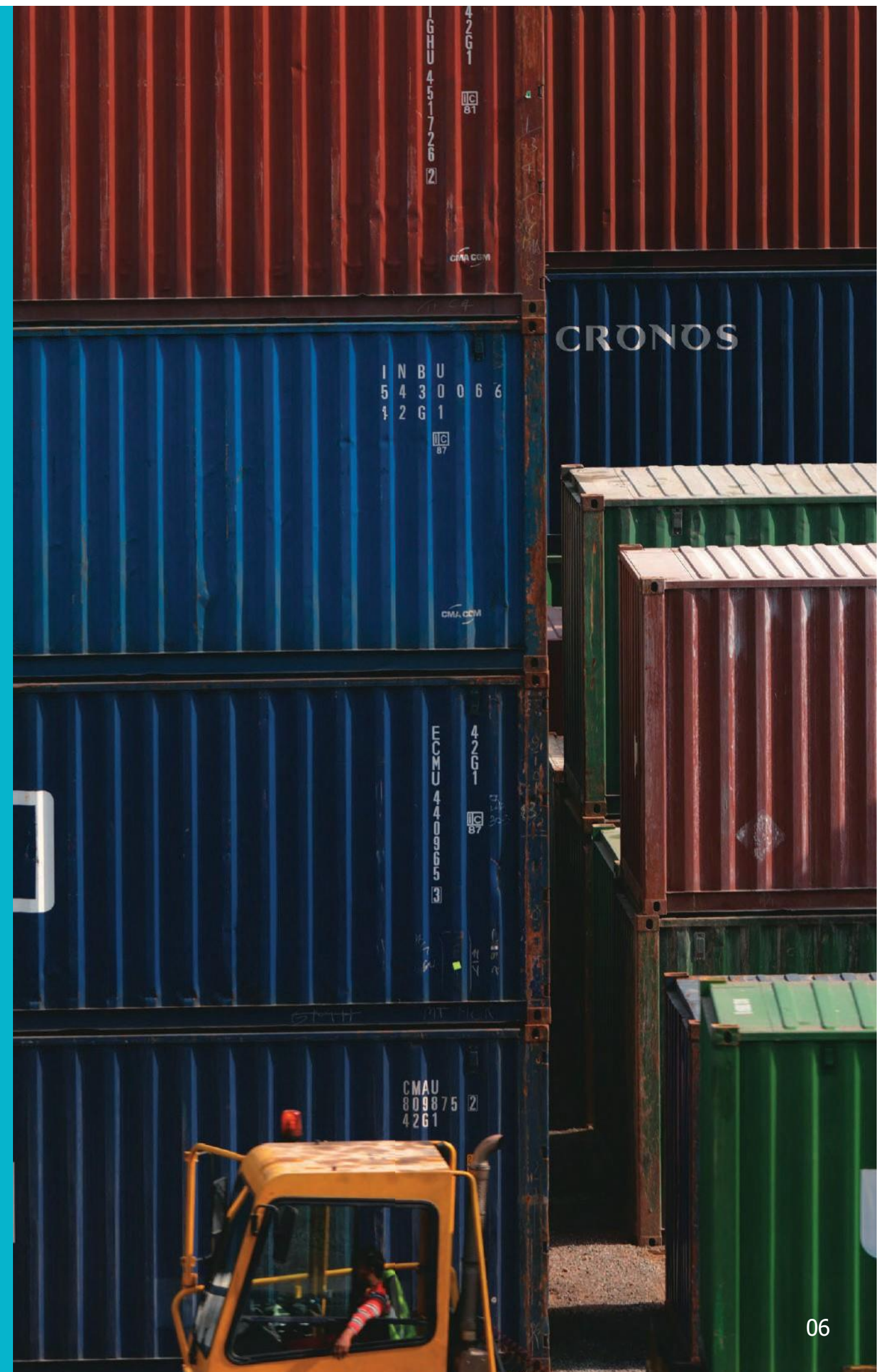

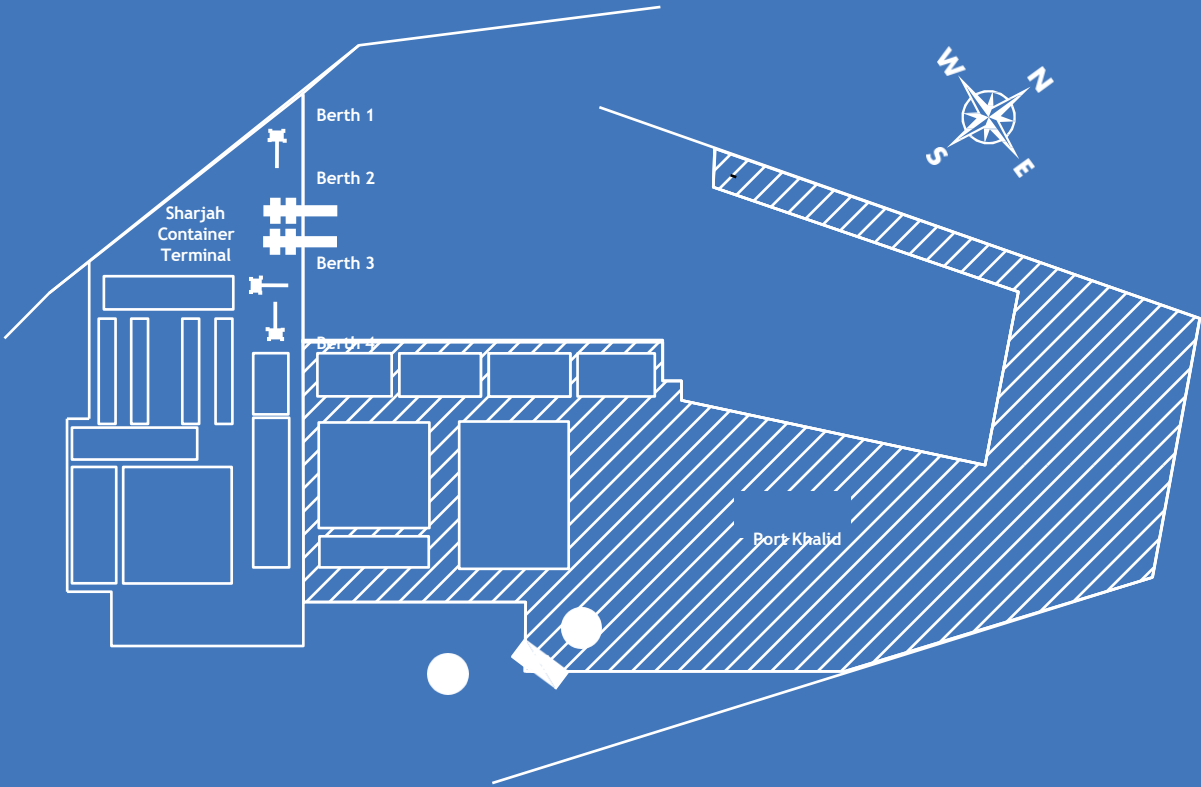
