GT USA's Canaveral Cargo Terminal (CCT) was successful in winning a bid to receive and assist in the assembly of one of Liebherr's largest mobile



harbourcrane in the US at its terminal. Once fully assembled, the new crane will remain on CCT's facility to assist the Space industry operations carried out in Port Canaveral, Florida.
