International Shipping Lines call at Gulftainer's Jubail Terminal

At Jubail Container Terminal, we welcomed a number of international vessels, Maersk Felixstowe, operating under the ME8 service of Maersk Line with a GRT of *57*,907 tonnes and a capacity of 3,995 TEU, as well as the vessel ESSEN EXPRESS, operating under the AG3 service of The Alliance (THEA) with a GRT of 142,395 tonnes and a capacity of 13,169 TEU, showcasing the exceptional operational capabilities of our Jubail terminal. Zina Sujith, our General Manager – Shipping Lines, and Anas Almuhaisen, General Manager – Operations in Saudi Arabia, along with their dedicated Gulftainer and Gulf Stevedoring Contracting (GSCCO) teams, were on-site to oversee the successful handling operation.

GSCCO handles first rail cargo operation directly from Jubail to Riyadh



The first live reefer shipment sent from Jubail to Riyadh was successfully handled by Gulftainer's subsidiary Gulf Stevedoring Contracting (GSCCO) in Saudi Arabia. This marks our second shipment consisting of 88 full import containers for MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company Line, among these were 10 live reefer containers efficiently loaded onto the train in a very short time span. Our capability to handle diverse and sensitive cargo, our readiness to manage additional volumes in Jubail, demonstrate our commitment to enhancing rail activity and improving logistics solutions in the region. This not only symbolises our dedication to service excellence but also our promise to enhancing our terminals and logistics centres' productivity.

Khorfakkan Terminal continues to grow, handle diverse cargoes for the world

Gulftainer, Momentum Logistics report 100% recycling of hazardous waste

Our transition from diesel-powered to electric rubber-tired cranes is setting a new standard in operational efficiency and emissions reduction. We have installed driver performance monitoring devices in our fleet to curb fuel wastage by reducing unnecessary acceleration and braking. Each year, Gulftainer sets and closely monitors specific sustainability goals. In 2023 alone, we reported no environmental accidents or incidents in Gulftainer's BUs across UAE, Iraq, KSA and the USA, ensured 100% recycling of hazardous waste, maintained a minimum vehicle fuel consumption of



9.2 km/gallon and achieved a 10% reduction in e-waste compared to the previous year. We have significantly reduced CO2 emissions from heavy vehicles on our roads "by investing heavily in rejuvenating our fleet with all new Scania trucks and trailers, ensuring we have the most up-to-date, future-proof and compliant vehicles", said Daniel Caton, Managing Director of Momentum Logistics, a subsidiary of Gulftainer.
