## **Gulftainer Customer Advisory**

### **Addendum**

This addendum is issued further to the Gulftainer Customer Advisory dated **06 March 2026** (**"Addendum"**). Considering the ongoing situation affecting terminal capacity and yard management at **Khorfakkan Container Terminal (KCT)**, Gulftainer ("Gulftainer" or the "Terminal Operator") is implementing the following additional temporary measures with immediate effect.

To ensure continuity of operations under the current constraints, **containers not collected within three (3) days from the date of vessel completion of operations may be relocated by Gulftainer to an inland facility—either the Sharjah Inland Container Dry Port or Saja'a Dry Port—for onward storage.** This transfer will be executed by the Terminal Operator for operational reasons **without further notice**, consistent with the stipulations outlined in the earlier advisory.

**All costs and risks arising from the inland transfer and subsequent storage** at the designated facility shall be **entirely for the account of the Shipping Line or Carrier.**

**Any charges related to inland transfer which remain unpaid at the date of this Addendum shall be billed directly to the Shipping Line or Carrier.**

Customers are strongly advised to prioritize **timely clearance and collection** of containers to avoid the application of additional inland transfer and storage costs.

These measures are **effective immediately** and will **remain in force until further notice**, supporting continued terminal fluidity during the present operational circumstances.
