Charges for Container Movements from KCT to Sajaa Dry Port

Date: 2nd April 2026

Please be advised that, with immediate effect, all container movements from Khorfakkan Container Terminal ("KCT") to Sajaa Dry Port for customs clearance within the Emirate of Sharjah will be subject to applicable transportation and handling charges payable by the consignee.

These charges shall apply irrespective of whether the movement is undertaken due to:

- KCT operational requirements;
- Customer requests or bookings; or
- Any related customer advisories issued by Gulftainer from time to time

The applicable one-way transportation charge from KCT to Sajaa Dry Port ("Corridor Fee") shall be charged in accordance with below **Momentum Logistics Customer Advisory** (ML_Advisory-2.4 issued on 1st April) payable by the consignee.

Please note that the Corridor Fee covers transportation only and does not include any storage, handling, customs-related, or other operational charges incurred at Sajaa Dry Port. Such charges will be billed separately and remain for the consignee's account.

All services and operations remain subject to applicable agreements, tariffs, and prevailing terms and conditions.

This advisory applies exclusively to cargo and containers cleared through customs in the Emirate of Sharjah. Charges and invoicing arrangements for cargo and containers cleared in other Emirates remain unchanged.

Dear Valued Customers,

Due to exceptional operating circumstances affecting yard capacity at Khorfakkan Commercial Terminal (**KCT**), the terminal is required to implement the following temporary operational measures with immediate effect.

Containers that are not collected within three (3) days from the date of vessel completion of operations will be automatically transferred to an inland facility, either **Sharjah Inland Container Depot** or **Saja'a Dry Port**, for onward storage.

Such transfer will be arranged by the terminal for operational reasons and without further notice. The costs and risks associated with the inland transfer and subsequent storage at the designated facility shall be for the account of the cargo interests.

For containers not cleared within three (3) days from KCT, the following charges will apply:

- **Transfer Delay Surcharge:** AED 3,491 per container
- **Operational Recovery Fee:** AED 400 per TEU

Without prejudice to the foregoing, **Momentum Logistics** reserves the right to recover any unpaid charges from cargo interests, relevant carrier or shipping line.

This measure is effective until further notice and is intended to support terminal operations during the current circumstances. Please note that the rates are subject to change at any time based on operational requirements.
