Container Movements from KCT to Sajaa Dry Port

Customer Advisory Addendum

Date: 26th March 2026

This Addendum is issued further to the Gulftainer Customer Advisory dated 06 March 2026 (the “Original Advisory”).

In light of the ongoing operational conditions affecting terminal capacity and yard utilization at Khorfakkan Container Terminal (“KCT”), Gulftainer (the “Terminal Operator”) is implementing the following additional temporary measures with immediate effect.

To support operational continuity and maintain terminal efficiency, containers that are not collected within **three (3) calendar days** from the date of vessel completion may be relocated by the Terminal Operator to a designated inland facility, **including Sharjah Inland Container Dry Port and/or Sajaa Dry Port**, for subsequent storage.

Such relocation may be undertaken by Gulftainer for operational reasons and without further notice, in accordance with the provisions outlined in the Original Advisory.

All costs, expenses, liabilities, and risks associated with the inland transfer and subsequent storage of containers at the designated facility shall be solely for the account of the respective Shipping Line or Carrier.

Any inland transfer charges that remain unpaid as of the date of this Addendum shall be invoiced directly to the relevant Shipping Line or Carrier.

Customers are strongly encouraged to ensure the timely clearance and collection of containers in order to avoid additional inland transfer, storage, and related operational charges.

These temporary measures shall take effect immediately and remain in force until further notice, supporting the continued fluidity and efficiency of terminal operations during the current operational circumstances.
