Dangerous Goods (DG) Cargo Declaration & Acceptance Requirements

Date: 20 June 2026

To ensure safe operations and compliance with regulatory requirements, Gulftainer would like to remind customers of the following Dangerous Goods (DG) cargo handling procedures applicable at Khorfakkan Container Terminal (KCT) and Sajaa Inland Container Depot.

Import and Export DG Cargo – Local Market

- All Dangerous Goods (DG) cargo destined for the local market must be routed through Sajaa (ICD), **except for Class 5.1 and Radioactive DG**
- Direct delivery of DG cargo from/to KCT to the local market will **no longer be permitted, except for Class 5.1 and Radioactive DG**
- DG containers will be transferred to Sajaa **same day** of availability
- Acceptance of DG cargo is limited to a maximum of **25 containers per vessel call for imports**, subject to operational capacity and approval
- For allocation of DG Exports, please reach out to your GT Business Partner or contact CS

Exceptions: Military cargo and **IMDG Class 1 and Class 5.1 (Oxidizing Substances)** and may be handled directly through sKCT, subject to approval.

Documentation Requirements

The following documents must be submitted prior to cargo acceptance:

- Dangerous Goods Declaration (DGD)
- Safety Data Sheet (SDS/MSDS)
- Container Packing Certificate (where applicable)
- Shipping Line Approval
- Any required regulatory permits

All DG cargo must be correctly declared, labelled, packed, and handled in accordance with the latest IMDG Code requirements.

Gulftainer reserves the right to reject, inspect, or restrict any DG cargo that does not meet safety, operational, or regulatory requirements.
